## **Dacia's General Director François Fourmont, proclaimed Citizen of Honour of Pitesti**

Dacia's General Director François Fourmont was today proclaimed citizen of honour of Pitesti, during a festivity held by the Town Council. The mayor of Pitesti handed the honorific diploma to François Fourmont for his contribution to the Romanian car industry and to the city's acknowledgement nation and worldwide.
